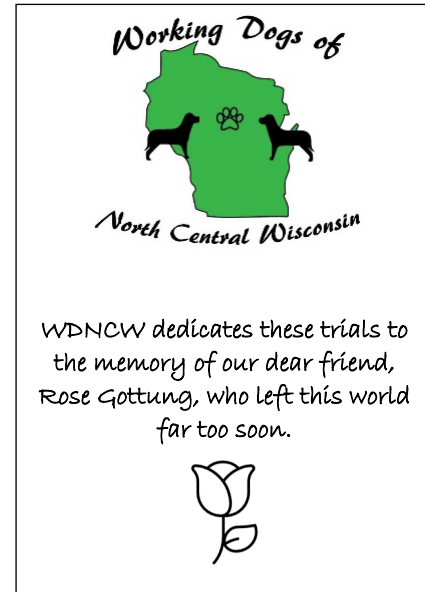

### **Refund Policy:**

**THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF APRIL 18.**

**Exception: for bitches in season with documentation from a vet.**

WDNCW per UKC rules, will retain 50% of entry fees as a processing fee for any Nosework competitor who provides a veterinarian's certificate verifying that the female came into season after the pre-entry deadline date for entries. The certificate may be mailed, provided the postmark is no later than the date prior to the day of the trial, or delivered by hand to the Event Secretary before the published start time of the trial.

### **COVID-19:**

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. By attending these events, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19. These trials will be held in accordance with UKC's suggested practices and in compliance with State of Wisconsin and local COVID-19 guidelines and regulations in effect at the time of the trials.

### **Notice:**

There will be no resets within a class per UKC Nosework regulations:

Only one dog per class or element, per handler. Entries with multiple dogs in the same class will be returned. For example, you may run one dog in novice vehicles, and another in advanced vehicles, but the same handler cannot run two dogs in novice vehicles in the same trial.

### **Food Options:**

### **Parking & Potty Areas:**

### **Crating:**

Indoor crating space will NOT be available. All crating must be done from the exhibitor's vehicle.

Exception on Saturday – there will be indoor crating space available for exhibitors that allow their vehicle to be used for the Vehicle searches.

### **Videographer / Photographer:**

There will not be videographers or photographers recording the searches.

## RV / Motorhome Camping:

A few RV camp sites are available at the Wisconsin Lions Camp on a first-reserved basis. Sites with 30 amp electricity and without electricity are available. The sites do not have water hook ups and no grey water dump station is available at the Wisconsin Lions Camp.
